At the Nara Prefecture Historical and Artistic Culture Complex, you will encounter history, art, and culture. Interactive engagement with all of the senses offers new discoveries and a fun learning experience.

**Restorations and Exhibition Wing**



In the Restorations and Exhibition Wing, four restoration studios are in operation year round, separately concentrating on Buddhist sculptures, paintings and writings, historical buildings, and archaeological discoveries. The processes and techniques used in restoration work are clearly explained through panel displays and videos. Exhibitions are held several times a year in the B1 exhibition rooms.

**Artistic Culture Wing**



This area is designed to engage visitors of all ages from infants up to stimulate wonder, raise questions, and lead to new discoveries through seeing, listening, and experiencing with all five senses. We hope that visitors are inspired to expand their horizons through more encounters with art or by creating art themselves. We also plan to extend the enjoyment of art by making active use of the traditional culture and local resources of Nara and promoting collaborations with the local community.

**Culture Exchange Wing**



The Culture Exchange Wing features a restaurant that serves dishes made from locally grown ingredients, a farmer's market that sells local produce, a traditional crafts shop, and a bicycle station with showers. Also, seminars are held regularly in the second floor Practice Room and Multipurpose Room to learn about and experience the food, agriculture, and traditional crafts of Nara Prefecture. The Practice Room can also be rented.

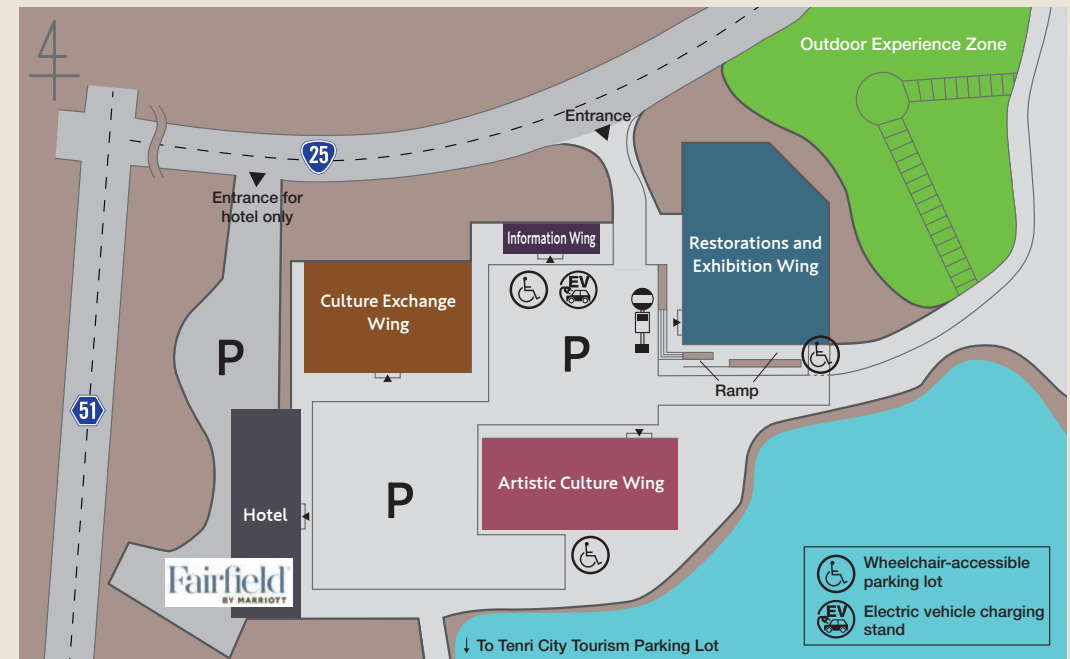
**Information Wing**



The Information Wing is a place where visitors can find local road and tourist information, as well as information on historical and cultural resources and art around Nara Prefecture. The restrooms and nursing room are open 24 hours a day.

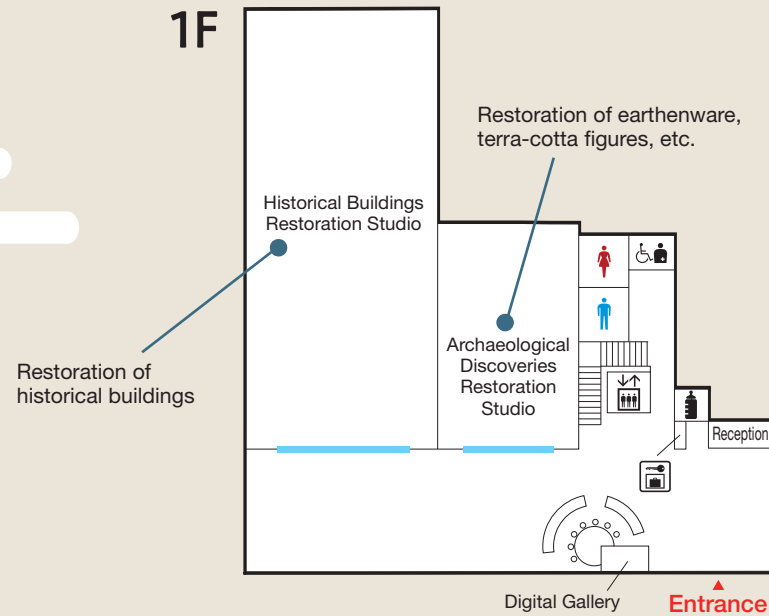

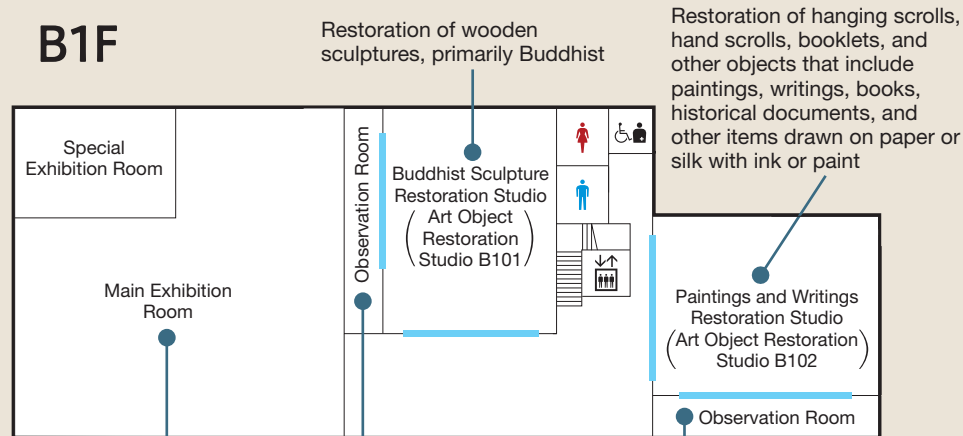

Exhibitions with hands-on elements featuring the restoration of historical and cultural properties of Nara Prefecture

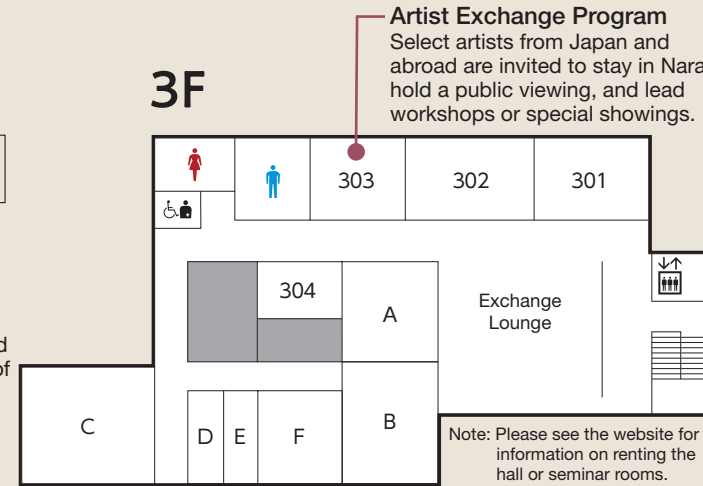
Explanatory tour is offered that includes watching restoration work in progress (reservations required).

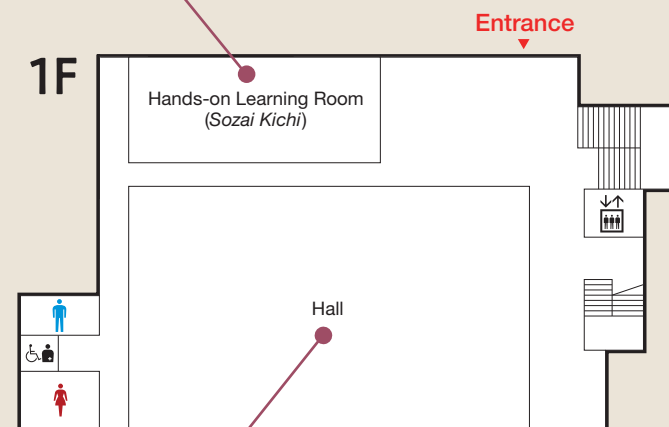

This art program for young children fosters creativity and cooperation using a variety of materials and emphasizes respect for each child's expression and individuality.

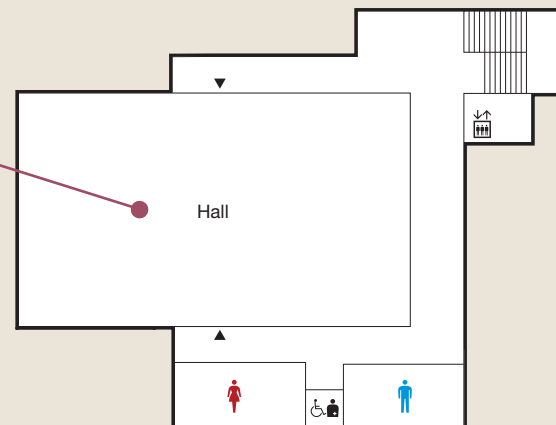


**Artist Exchange Program**
